Emergency and First Aid Procedures

INHALATION: Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Call a physician.

EYE OR SKIN CONTACT: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Hold eyelids open during flushing. Call a physician. Wipe or brush off as much material as possible from skin, then follow up with water. Sponge or rinse off remainder using water. Get medical attention if skin irritation occurs.

INGESTION: If conscious, drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Take immediately to a hospital or physician. If vomiting occurs, administer additional water. If unconscious or in convulsions, take immediately to a hospital. Do not attempt to induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

NOTES TO PHYSICIAN INCLUDING ANTIDOTES: Treat symptomatically.

CONTAINS SILICA: Silica may cause lung disease.
