

# LEONARDITE PRODUCTS

## Emergency and First Aid Procedures

**INHALATION:** Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Call a physician.

**EYE OR SKIN CONTACT:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Hold eyelids open during flushing. Call a physician. Wipe or brush off as much material as possible from skin, then follow up with water. Sponge or rinse off remainder using water. Get medical attention if skin irritation occurs.

**INGESTION:** If conscious, drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Take immediately to a hospital or physician. If vomiting occurs, administer additional water. If unconscious or in convulsions, take immediately to a hospital. Do not attempt to induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**NOTES TO PHYSICIAN INCLUDING ANTIDOTES:** Treat symptomatically.

**CONTAINS SILICA:** Silica may cause lung disease.
